Opening Remarks By Revd Dr Joshua Sudharman, Warden of SPH

For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? And how are they to preach unless they are sent? (Romans 10:14–15a, ESV)

Paul applies solid logic to the issue of preaching of the gospel to the unsaved.

- To be saved (F), one must first call upon the Lord (E).
- To call upon the Lord, one must first believe in the Lord (D).
- To believe in the Lord, one must first hear of the Lord (C).
- To hear of the Lord, someone else must first preach to them (B).
- To preach about the Lord, one must first be sent (A).

To get to outcome (F), one has to go through steps (A) to (E).

St Peter's Hall (SPH) is the training arm of the Diocese. We exist to support and supplement the parishes in their efforts to disciple and equip members. To do that, we offer a growing range of training and teaching resources. Our hope is to serve you. Your flourishing and effectiveness is our success!

This is where the logic of Paul in Romans 10 is relevant. We want ultimately to see our Anglican members edified, equipped, trained and raised to previously unreached levels of effectiveness and flourishing in their journeys as disciples!

But how can they reach these levels if they have not received the necessary feeding? And how can they receive the feeding if they have never directly engaged with the training content and resources? And how can they engage directly with the training resources if they never even knew they existed? And how can they know of the existence of these training resources if nobody ever told them? And how can someone tell them unless they are sent from SPH?

So this is the reason SPH is doing a 'roadshow' this year, to raise awareness among our parishes that we exist, and that we have a growing repository of training content that can enhance your discipleship journeys.



Since there is a substantial diversity of training needs, we have identified "Levels" which denote seniority of leadership. The following diagram seeks to illustrate how both the In-Service Staff and Lay Members can be stratified into 3 layers each:





<u>Seminarians</u>



The Seminarians refer to the Anglicans enrolled in Trinity Theological College, who are automatically part of the St Peter's Hall community in TTC, and are affectionately known as Petereans. Most of them will obtain a theological diploma or degree and go on to serve in full-time pastoral ministry in the Diocese or Deaneries. There are approximately 30 of them at any given time.







In-Service Staff

The In-Service Staff refer to all hired or salaried staff serving in the Diocese, i.e. those who are paid for their services to the Diocese. They may be employed by the Diocese, or by the parishes, or by Diocese-related entities (e.g. St Andrew's Mission Hospital, Singapore Anglican Community Services, Anglican Preschool Services).



<u>Laity</u>

The Lay Members (or Laity) are the members of our Anglican parishes, who are regular worshippers. Some may be serving in ministries and holding leadership roles within their churches, but these roles are voluntary and not salaried. There is typically a partnership and cooperation between the In–Service Staff and the Lay Members in carrying out the various ministries of the church.
